Neighborhood Associations

1. What is a "Neighborhood Association?"

It is an official group created by people living near to each other.

There are many neighborhood associations in Hino Town.

Joining a neighborhood association enables you to meet and make friends with

the people living nearby.

We work together to make their community safe and livable.

2. Neighborhood Association/Council Activities

()We work together for a safe and secure community.

OIn case of an earthquake or fire, we practice evacuation.

OWe also practice putting out fires.





OProtecting children

Members watch over the local children going to/from school to prevent traffic accidents.



OMembers check in on the elderly living alone.



OMembers patrol the streets to prevent robberies and molestation.

②Keeping the Town Clean

OMembers look after the streets and parks. They also keep the rubbish

collection area clean.



3. Disposal/collection of rubbish

ORubbish is separated and disposed of by type.

There are rules about what rubbish to throw away each day of the week.

Separate and dispose of your rubbish according to the rules for the area where you live.

OTake out your rubbish on the morning of the day the collector comes.

OLeave it at the designated collection spot.

ORubbish may only be disposed of on certain days.

OUse ONLY Hino Town designated rubbish bags.

Designated bags may be purchased at stores in Hino.

OIf something is unclear, ask someone living nearby or the town office.

4. Getting along with the people living nearby

OGreet people who live nearby when you see them.

ODo not make loud noises or speak loudly in the early

morning or at night.



5. For a healthy and enjoyable life

OAn 'athletic day' is held. Everyone enjoys getting exercise together.

OThere are festivals. Many delicious foods are sold.

Enjoy these events with other people in town.



6. Information about daily life

OThe town office distributes various information about Hino.

It is useful for your daily life.



OCirculars (notices from the neighborhood and/or town office) are passed

around. Read them and then pass them along to the next house.

7. Neighborhood association fees

OEach neighborhood association collects fees from all members.



OThe fees collected are used to pay for necessary items.

OThe amount is determined by each neighborhood association.

OFee collection will be explained by the neighborhood association leader

when he/she welcomes you.

Use ONLY Hino Town rubbish bags.

Rubbish bags for Hino Town are sold at most stores in town.
